We have outlined some very important expectations below.

Please initial that you understand these expectations and details about your field trip.

_____ I understand that I must stay with my assigned chaperone at all times.

_____ I understand that I am expected to make good choices, be respectful, walk, and use a quiet voice.

_____ I understand that I must be respectful to other students, my teacher, the chaperones, and the exhibition staff.

_____ I understand that I am at **Titanic: The Artifact Exhibition** to learn. I will make at least 3 quality observations at each exhibit. I will notice the size, shape, color, patterns, structure, form/function, adaptations, mouth shape, and unique features.

_____ I understand that photos and videos are not allowed.

_____ I understand that the escalators, elevators, railings, ledges, and benches are not playground equipment. I will not swing from or do flips on the railings. I will not stand on, run across, or jump from ledges or benches.

_____ I understand that my group and I are responsible for being at the assigned meeting locations at the correct time.

_____ I understand that no outside food or drink is allowed in the exhibition hall and that there is no available space to store lunch boxes.

_____ I understand that there is no re-entry to the exhibition hall. I may not leave and re-enter during my field trip.

_____ I understand that because of fire marshal maximum occupancy regulations and exhibition layout, groups may not use the employee bathrooms.

_____ If visiting the gift shop, I understand that I must be with my chaperone at all times and that I must pay for anything that I take or any items that I break.

_____ If I use the outside courtyard area, I understand it is not a playground. For my safety and the well-being of those around me, I will not run on the stage area, jump over the water features, or throw anything.

_____ I understand that I am a representative for my school/group. My behavior can positively or negatively impact future field trips for my school/group. My teacher/leader may also impose additional consequences.
